THE LINDA GILMAN DISTINGUISHED PEDIATRIC NURSE PRACTITIONER STUDENT AWARD

PURPOSE: The Linda Gilman Distinguished Pediatric Nurse Practitioner Student Award is awarded annually to a graduate student who best exemplifies a desire to contribute to the improvement in pediatric health care and excellence in the clinical and academic setting.

CRITERIA:

1. The applicant must be in good academic standing in his/her graduate program.
2. The individual must demonstrate a desire to improve/impact pediatric health care.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

Submit the following:

- a. A current Curriculum Vitae
- b. A double-spaced typed narrative describing qualities the applicant demonstrates in support of the award (500 words or less)
- c. Two reference letters of support. One must be from a faculty member

DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION:

1. Applications must be submitted by **March 1** to the Indiana Chapter of the National Association of Pediatric Nurse Practitioners
